1. Research Awards

1. Purpose:

Research Awards aim at encouraging and recognizing the research contributions of the outstanding researchers of National University of Modern Languages (NUML). The incentive in terms of *certificate of appreciation* is envisaged to promote research activities and enhance the quality of research carried out by faculty/staff members of NUML.

2. Scope:

All NUML faculty/staff members can apply for this award.

3. Policy Statement:

A Certificate of Appreciation and a Shield will be given to Outstanding Researchers of the Calendar Year in the following format.

4. Procedure:

4.1 In Ceremony of Convocation, 'minimum top eight' researchers will be recognized.

4.2 Top *three* researchers in the University will be ranked based on their scores against parameters mentioned below.

After that *one* top researcher will be selected from *each* faculty on the basis of their scores against the parameters.

4.3 Procedure of recognizing contributions of researchers is based on following parameters:

- i** Publications
- ii** Papers in Conference Proceedings
- iii** Books and Book Chapters (HEC Recognized only)
- iv** Patents
- v** Research Supervision
- vi** Research Grants
- vii** Research Commercialization

4.4 All the research endeavors by the faculty members of NUML within the concerned calendar year shall be forwarded on the Scoring Sheet (Section 1.1) in duly typed form to Registrar Office through HOD, Dean Faculty, and/or Regional Director for further processing and approval by the Rector.
